Without having this form back for Mrs Smith to look at, the absence will go as unauthorised.

You **MUST** still return the order proofcard & envelope to school with a note on the envelope stating you have paid by card.

Website orders are subject to a home delivery charge. If you wish to have your order returned to school free of charge with the other school orders, please use the promo code **SCHDEL** at the checkout. To take advantage of this offer you **MUST** put your child's name in the order notes & order early, any orders placed after the school orders are dispatched will not benefit from the free school delivery. We would advise ordering within 2 weeks of the school handing out the proofcards.
