School Rules

6. We will respect our equipment keeping it safe, tidy and clean.
7. We will inform an adult if we feel unwell.

Children are allowed to bring joggers or leggings in case lessons are outside. Please make sure any jewellery such as earrings are removed for P.E. lessons.

Children will NOT be completing BookBlog homework this half term. I will give children paper reading homework in their homework books. I will give out reading, maths and literacy homework every week and children are expected to complete it and bring it into school to be marked.
